- Home corners will be changed regularly to show different cultures, races, and the world around us.

We aim to show respect and awareness of all major events in the lives of the children attending Sarratt Ducklings. It is the policy of Sarratt Ducklings to positively value and respect people regardless of their gender, ethnic origins/racial groups, religions, cultures, linguistic backgrounds, age and abilities.

We aim to provide learning opportunities for all children in our community. All the children are valued for themselves and are encouraged to share their experiences with us, and each other, without any discrimination. Children are not excluded from activities. It is our policy to share information with each other.

We welcome the diversity of all the children's backgrounds. To achieve this, we invite parents into the sessions to relate and share with us some of their various festivals and celebrations. We also ask the parents to suggest any positive ideas they may have, which will help their child to settle in easily and quickly when they are starting with us at Sarratt Ducklings.
